 Level 3	90 clock hours Core of Knowledge training that includes: A minimum of 20 clock hours in child development and 20 clock hours in curriculum methods. (The 45 clock hours completed at level two carries over to level three.) 2 professional activity units 1 year of experience or 1 year of college	18 clock hours continued training and 2 professional activity units per year
 Level 4	135 clock hours Core of Knowledge training consisting of: 45 clock hours in child development, 30 clock hours in curriculum methods, 20 clock hours in health, safety and nutrition, 15 clock hours in special needs, 15 clock hours in professionalism; and 10 clock hours in community issues.
